<p>Mr. Damon So</p> <p>Mr. So is a Consultant with Lovells. He initially qualified as a Chartered Civil and Structural Engineer. He later qualified as a solicitor specializing in construction law. Damon has since undertaken a wide range of construction related legal work, acting for main contractors, sub-contractors, employers, professionals and insurers in respect of building and civil projects, both in Hong Kong and overseas. He has had occasion to consider many of the issues and disputes which typically arise in respect of such projects. In particular, he has given advice in respect of a number of major projects in Macau.</p>	<p>The speaker will give an introduction to basic civil law principles applicable in Macau. He will focus on certain issues repeatedly facing Hong Kong parties having a project in Macau or entering into a contract with a Macau company. Such issues relate to choice of law, conflict of laws, arbitration law and execution of deeds. It should be of interest to contractors and developers alike who have done or are considering doing work in Macau.</p>
