Speaker	Synopsis
<p>Mr. Ivan Cheung Ivan is a Partner with international built asset consultancy, EC Harris LLP. He is a Chartered Quantity Surveyor practising as Arbitrator, Adjudicator, Mediator and Expert Witness to facilitate resolution of construction and engineering disputes.</p> <p>Ivan started his career as a quantity surveyor with Levett and Bailey. There he drew experience in all aspects of quantity surveying duties on various projects which have included residential, commercial, industrial, hotel, museum, racecourse, airport cargo terminal, refurbishment works, interior fitting out works and electrical and mechanical works for clients including local government, schools, universities and private investors.</p> <p>Ivan joined Harold Crowter Associate (HK) as a Claims Analyst specialising in the analysis and preparation of both claim and defence submissions on quantum issues for construction disputes. He became Associate Director with Ho + Allington in February 2004. His specific experience has included the provision of general advice, the preparation of a number of expert reports and giving evidence at hearings on quantum and/or contractual issues for the purpose of arbitration, court proceedings or mediation.</p> <p>Ivan is a practising member of the Academy of Expert and he has been accredited within EC Harris as an Expert Witness under an accreditation process conducted by the Academy of Experts. He has been appointed as Quantum Expert Witness on fourteen different construction and engineering disputes and has given oral evidence in arbitration tribunal and courts on four occasions.</p> <p>In the capacity of a member on Panel of HKIAC Accredited Mediators, he has been nominated for appointments on a number of occasions.</p>	<p>The Hong Kong construction industry has typically followed traditional contract strategies. The local government has however maintained an interest and tracked the development of the NEC in the UK.</p> <p>The government is actively considering through various departments a series of pilot projects to use NEC3, and EC Harris is pleased to be working with DSD on the first pilot project, and also HyD on the second pilot project.
