Site Visit to Multi-Media Building of City University of Hong Kong

Organized by : The Hong Kong Institute of Construction Managers

Introduction

The proposed site of Multi-Media Building is situated on a platform formed along the hillside of Cornwall Street and Tat Hong Road in Kowloon Tong.

The Works comprises of the construction of pad & strip footing foundation founded on rock and a 9-storey high reinforced concrete superstructure campus building in highly irregular geometrical shape. The overall building height is 45 m above ground whereas the total GFA is about 24,580 m².

The entire superstructure is fair-faced concrete with mineral paint finished externally, supported by many inclined load-bearing external walls of various inclination sloping either inward or outward, some inclined columns and internal core walls forming the main features of this new campus building. Some roofs and canopy structures are also inclined which add more interest to the building. Both long span beam and flat slab are designed for the floor construction. The headroom varies quite significantly from floor to floor.

The layout on each floor is not at all simple and you can hardly find little resemblance between floors. Finishes to the interior are highly specialized and sophisticated in nature in addition to the high acoustic performance requirement. Besides, there will be many audio-visual and IT equipment to co-ordinate and install.

The structure will be topped out shortly on early November and project is due to complete in August 2010.
