Speaker	Synopsis
<p>Dr. Y Y Wong Dr. Wong started his career in the occupational Safety & Health as a Factory Inspector of Labour Department. He left the Government after 8 years of service and worked in various construction projects for more than 10 years before he was appointed as the Executive Director of the Occupational Safety & Health Council when it was set up in 1988. He formed Y. Y. Wong Safety Consultants Limited in 1994.</p> <p>Dr. Wong is a Civil Engineer by training and obtained his Ph.D. degree from the University of South Australia on business and management. He is a Fellow member and Registered Safety Practitioner of the Institute of Occupational Safety and Health in U.K, a Fellow of the Royal Institute for the Promotion of Health. He is also a Certified Safety Professional of the United States. Dr. Wong is a Fellow member and was the past President of the Hong Kong Occupational Safety and Health Association of Hong Kong and founder President of the Society of Accredited Safety Auditors.</p> <p>Dr. Wong has involved in a lot of safety activities, and has been a Member of Safety Officers Advisory Committee of the Hong Kong Government. He is also acting as part time lecturer in Hong Kong Polytechnic University and Construction Industry Training Authority and speaker in public safety seminars and conferences.</p> <p>As a safety consultant, Dr. Wong has involved himself in over 1,000 safety and health audits for different companies, including contractors and manufacturing plants. These audits were conducted on behalf of the ETWB and Housing Authority as well as the discharge of obligations under the Factories and Industrial Undertakings (Safety Management) Regulations. Dr. Wong has been engaged as Expert Witness in Civil Claim cases and in Magistrates Courts in numerous occasions.</p>	<p>Modern safety management system faces a huge challenge in its implementation due to the behaviour of workers who ignore safety procedures and adoption of safe practices. Group induction training and toolbox talks have not proven to achieve significant results in enhancing the safety awareness of workers.</p>  <p>[BOOST], a safety training module developed by Dr. Y Y Wong after years of research, aims to identify and change the safety behavior of workers particularly in the construction industry. It includes the identification and observation of mis-behavior, confirming the causes, followed by individual coaching and instruction. This has proved to be effective in removing repetitive mis-behavior and the upgrading of safety awareness and participation of workers in adopting safety performances.</p>
