<p>Synopsis</p>	<p>: Traditionally, “Litigation” is expensive and “Court proceeding” may take a long time to get to a resolution in Construction Disputes. After the Civil Justice Reform initiated by the Judiciary of Hong Kong, “Mediation” has become one of the most effective alternative dispute resolution methods that would allow the disputing parties to control the format and pace of how to settle their Construction disputes in efficient manners, and would allow the parties to stay in control of the settlement outcomes.</p> <p>This seminar aims to share the advantages and limitation of Mediation and will provide some valuable mediator’s insights when resolving Construction Disputes. It will also give a useful introduction on some basic theories and concepts on Mediation, Arbitration and other most popular Alternative Dispute Resolution methods in Hong Kong Construction Industry, their relative benefits and differences against traditional civil litigation proceedings. Practicing experiences from the perspective of mediator will also be shared.</p>
